News update from United Arab Emirates

J.P.S Yacht and Charter Service would like to take this opportunity to mention some recent events that have happened in the UAE and need to be brought to the attention of all yachts visiting, or intending to visit, the UAE.

Weapons and drugs, including certain prescription drugs such as codeine, are illegal in the UAE and are not to be brought into the country under any circumstances. All enquiries must be tabled prior to arrival.

We have recently had a boat under arrest for a month due to weapons being on board at the time of clearance and not being declared prior to arrival, and the case is still pending.

We have been heavily involved with the police and immigration departments trying to get a clearer picture on what is acceptable or not to enter the UAE.

When visiting the UAE, contact J.P.S Yacht and Charter Service for assistance and we will be able to point you in the right direction in terms of your medication on board, weapons / security, and all your port agency requirements while you are visiting.
